


Locating eNCPT Spreadsheet

1. Visit www.ncpro.org and click on the Login button in the corner.



(Use the most up-to-date version of Google Chrome for the best results)

2. Log in with your username and password and click “Sign In.”



3. Select the English edition and click “Launch Publication.”

Please note the change of the terminology's name from International Dietetics and Nutrition Terminology (IDNT) to Nutrition Care Process Terminology. This name change is official as of the 2014 edition of the terminology

Worksheets and Attributes Contained in this Workbook

Worksheet: e2015 Published Hierarchy

This worksheet contains comprehensive information on this edition of NCPT including the following attributes:

Attribute	Description
ANDUID	Unique identifier for NCPT terms. This value should be used as a unique identifier for NCPT in information systems. All other values are subject to change
NCPT_Term_w_Context	The full NCPT Term, including enough contextual information to differentiate it from other terms. This terms is preferred for use in the electronic medical records.
Pub_Term_Indent	The publication terms with indentation to express the various levels of the hierarchy. This terms is sometimes identical, but often contains less information than the NCPT Term with Context.
	Each Nutrition Care Porcess Terms is associated with a step

- All terminology from the current edition of the eNCPT

- A mapping from the previous edition to the current edition
- Alphanumeric codes used in building an EHR
- Codes referencing how the terminology is being mapped to SNOMED/LOINC body of medical terminology.
